REASONS FOR DECISION UNDER *ENVIRONMENT EFFECTS ACT 1978*

Title of Proposal: Officer City Gate

Proponent: Vic Gas Distribution Pty Ltd

Description of Project:

The construction of a natural gas pressure regulator and associated telemetry to reinforce the existing natural gas supply network in Officer and Beaconsfield to meet expected demand over winter 2007.

The project is located on the western side of Officer South Road, Officer South. The site is predominantly located within the existing gas easement. See attached map and plan.

Decision:

The Minister for Planning has decided that an environment effects statement is not required for the proposed Officer City Gate.

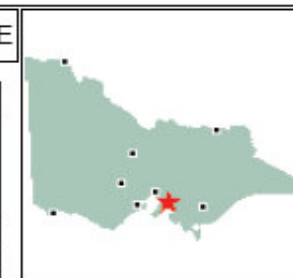
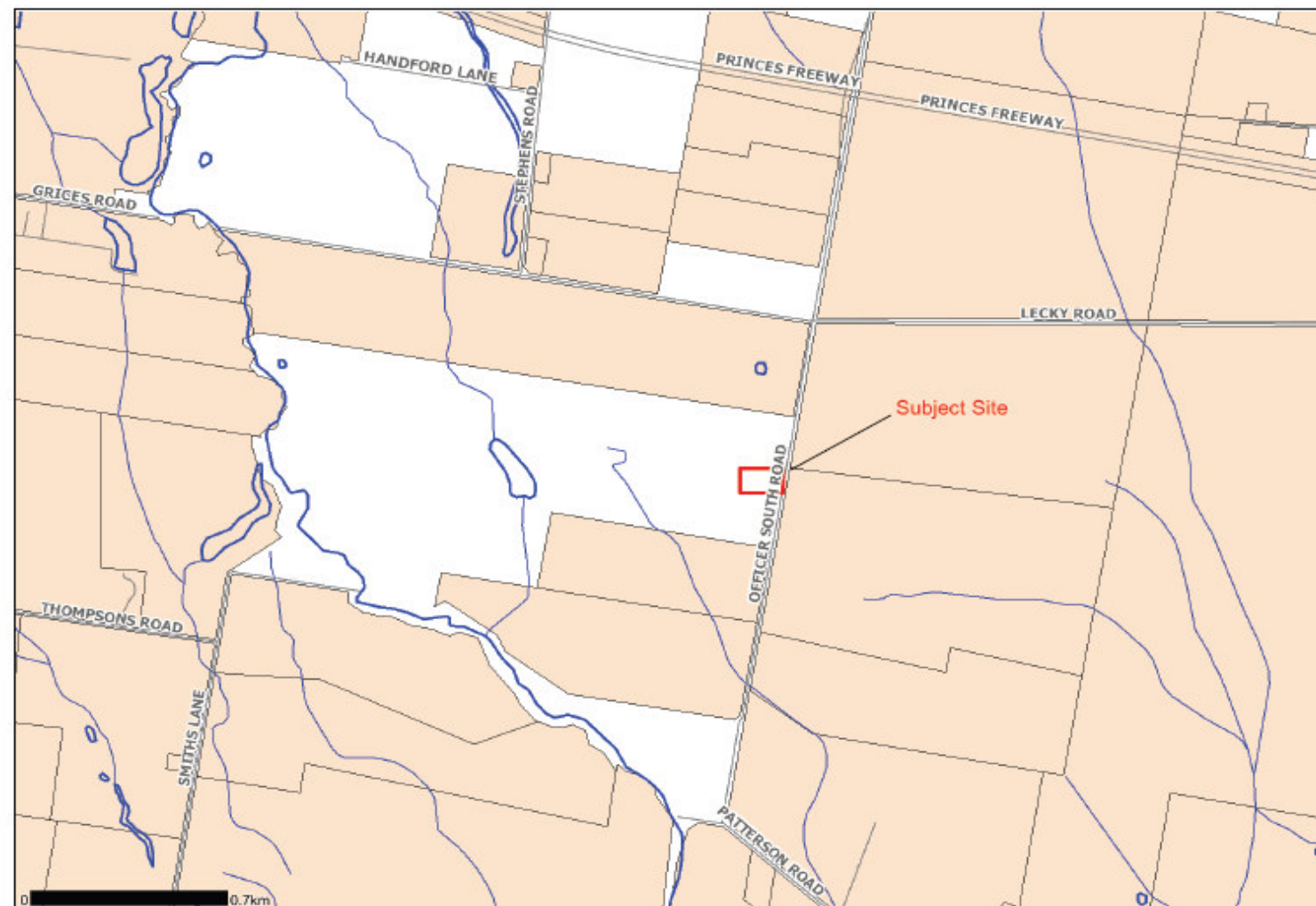
Reasons for Decision:
