

# Proposed planning scheme changes for 1548 Boorhaman Road, Boorhaman

Information sheet

The Department of Treasury and Finance (DTF) has requested changes to the planning provisions for 1548 Boorhaman Road, Boorhaman (the site) which is owned by the Department of Education and Training (DET).

DET has determined the site is surplus to its operational requirements. DTF, on behalf of DET, has requested that the planning provisions for the site be changed to enable the land to be sold.

## What is proposed to change?

DTF has requested the following changes to the planning provisions for the site:

Existing provisions	Proposed change
Public Use Zone – Schedule 2 (Education)	Township Zone
Heritage Overlay – Schedule 212	Retain

## Site details

The site is approximately 0.80 ha and was formerly the Boorhaman Primary School which closed in 2008. The site contains mature vegetation and several school buildings, including the heritage listed school building which was constructed in 1877.
