I am now extremely concerned at the degree to which the planned West Gate Tunnel project will funnel traffic into an inner city not infrastructurally prepared. As with the Eastern Freeway currently, traffic will be funneled off the proposed roading and onto city-fringe streets where it will be abandoned by planners. Some months ago I attended the West Melbourne Ideas Workshop hosted by the City of Melbourne... pursuant to their 'Participate Melbourne' project and the drafting of their West Melbourne Structure Plan.
