Proposed Development Opportunity at Ormond Station

Have your say on draft planning controls to facilitate a proposed development opportunity at Ormond Station

Introduction

As part of the Victorian Government's commitment to remove 50 of the worst level crossings in Victoria, the congested and dangerous level crossing at North Road Ormond has recently been removed.

The removal of the crossing and the construction of the new Ormond Station provides an opportunity for a mixed use development at a transport hub.

The public are invited to make submissions on the draft planning controls to facilitate development at Ormond Station and the Minister for Planning has appointed an independent Advisory Committee to consider submissions and provide advice on the proposed development opportunity.

Proposal

To allow any future development, there needs to be changes to the planning scheme.

A proposed development may include residential apartments with direct access to Ormond Station. It may also include retail and commercial opportunities.



The Site

Draft planning controls to facilitate a mixed use development have been prepared.

The proposal includes:

- rezoning the site to the Comprehensive Development Zone to allow for a mix of residential, commercial and retails uses.
- allowing a range of building heights across the site from 5 – 6 storeys up to 12 – 13 storeys.
- allowing primary vehicle access from Katandra Road and secondary vehicle access from Newham Grove.
- making the Minister for Planning responsible for deciding applications for the site.
- exemptions from the notice requirements and review rights of the *Planning and Environment Act 1987*.

All submissions will be treated as public documents.

Please note that Glen Eira City Council is unable to receive submissions.

What will the Advisory Committee do?

The Advisory Committee will consider all written submissions received on the draft planning controls and convene a Public Hearing before producing a report for the Minister for Planning.

Can I make a presentation at the Public Hearing?

All submitters will have the opportunity to make a presentation at the Public Hearing.

You are welcome to attend any part of the Public Hearing even if you do not make a submission.
