Improved standards are excellent but the government also needs to look at tenancy laws. New flats are far more likely to be purchased by investors than by owner occupiers or first home buyers. Tenants need protection from arbitrary rent increases and need improved amenity standards. For example, landlords do not under law need to provide heating, and may increase rent by the highest percentage possible under market conditions. So its great to have improved building standards for apartments, but we also need to look after the tenants who will be living in them and not allow the improved standard of the flat to be used as a leverage point by unscrupulous landlords who exploit tenants under cover of (unfair) tenancy laws.
