Planning and Environment Act 1987

ORDER IN COUNCIL SPECIFYING INCOME RANGES FOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING Order in Council

1. Purpose

The purpose of this Order is to specify income ranges for affordable housing that is not social housing for the purposes of the **Planning and Environment Act 1987**.

2. Authorising provision

This Order is made under section 3AB of the **Planning and Environment Act 1987** which provides that the Governor in Council, on recommendation of the Minister for Planning, by Order published in the Government Gazette, may specify a range of household income as a very low income range, a low income range and a moderate income range.

3. Commencement

This Order comes into operation on 1 July 2025.

4. Interpretation

Words and phrases in the Order have the same meaning as in the **Planning and Environment** Act 1987.

5. Revocation

The Order published in the Government Gazette No. G 26 on 27 June 2024 on page 1222 entitled 'Section 3AB – Specification of Income Ranges' is revoked as of 30 June 2025.

6. Specification of income ranges for affordable housing

The Governor in Council, on the recommendation of the Minister for Planning, under section 3AB of the **Planning and Environment Act 1987**, hereby specifies, with respect to affordable housing that is not social housing, the following ranges to be the very low income range, the low income range and the moderate income range –
