Pick My Park has announced funding of over \$17 million for park projects, including 14 new parks and 83 upgraded parks across Melbourne and regional areas. The list of funded projects is provided below.

Pick My Park

The \$30 million Pick My Park program gives the community a say on grants for new and upgraded parks.

Round 1 of the Pick My Park program focused on key areas identified in [Plan for Victoria](#) to accommodate additional housing. It included the suburbs surrounding the 60 centres of the Train and Tram Zone Activity Centre Program and 15 Priority Precincts (including the Suburban Rail Loop precincts) across Melbourne as well as Ballarat, Bendigo and Geelong.

In 2025, Victorians aged 16 and over shared their ideas on the park projects they wanted to see delivered, and their priorities for parks. Successful project applications demonstrated alignment to community feedback and met the requirements of the program guidelines.
