NATIONAL AIRPORTS SAFEGUARDING FRAMEWORK (NASF)

The National Airports Safeguarding Framework (NASF) is a national land use planning framework which provides guidance on a number of airport safeguarding matters including managing the risk of wildlife strikes in the vicinity of airports (Guideline C). It is a policy document in all planning schemes at Clause 18.04. The Australian Aviation Wildlife Hazard Group will be running a workshop for industry, local government, regulators and anyone else involved in management or policy issues related to the intersection of wildlife, aircraft and airports on **July 23 and 24 at Sydney Airport (International)**. Feedback on the practical application of NASF Guideline C will be sought at the workshop to assist the National Airports Safeguarding Advisory Group in identifying / prioritising projects for its future work program.
