Suburban Revitalisation Program

The Suburban Revitalisation Program supported local projects in metropolitan areas to boost liveability, economic growth, and community connection through partnerships with councils, businesses, and communities.

The program established 8 Suburban Revitalisation Boards in Boronia, Broadmeadows, Frankston, Lilydale, Melton, Noble Park, Reservoir and Tarneit, each chaired by a local MP and made up of representatives from councils, businesses, service providers, and community organisations.

In total, the program funded \$49,143,345 to deliver 271 projects, with an overall value of over \$112 million.
